### Message from the Chair



We're back! It is a relief to finally get back to providing grants to our community once again. Last year we provided just over \$20,000 in grants from the general community fund and almost \$15,000 in scholarships to high school graduates.

We were fortunate last year to be the recipients of Southside Foodmart's community rewards program. A total of \$1,500 was raised in hot dog sales and portions of items sold in the month of May 2010. Many thanks to the owners/managers of Southside, Alan and Georgina Chin, for their generosity and choosing the Foundation as the beneficiary.

Another \$1,500 was raised at the annual Revelstoke Community Foundation Pro-Am golf tournament as amateurs and pros from all around gather in early July for another great golf tournament. Thanks to the incredible job by John and Pam Frank, golf club staff, tournament sponsors, and golfers who participated.

New to the board of directors this year is Randy Driediger. Randy is the Revelstoke Credit Union representative replacing Pat Mckee. Thanks Pat for your contributions over the year and we would like to welcome Randy to our board. Not wasting anytime Randy has joined the grant making committee.

A Columbia Basin Trust regional initiative is underway to find programs and services that could be used collectively or shared to find better economies of operation for Columbia Basin foundations. There are many smaller foundations that struggle in administration or marketing to grow their Foundations to a size that is self sustaining. We are encouraged by the collaborative efforts and are involved in ongoing discussions.

The youth in philanthropy committee continues to make good contact with children in the elementary school system to promote and support the concept of community giving. Many thanks to Linda Dickson, David Rooney and Meghann Hutton for their work on this committee.

The Jim Holdener Memorial Fund was created to remember our community friend, Jim Holdener, who passed away suddenly in March of 2010. Jim's wife, Sue Holdener, has asked that the proceeds of the fund be used for programs that benefit youth and children in Revelstoke. Thank-you to the Holdener family for selecting the foundation and supporting the future of Revelstoke.

The creation of the Revelstoke Community Environmental Fund was announced at the March 2011 meeting of the Revelstoke Community Foundation. This fund will be used to support environmental initiatives in our community. Monies earned by this fund will eventually help the knowledgeable organizations who work in the environmental sector. The capital in the fund will not be encroached thus making it a perpetual gift for our community. To kick start the fund, the directors of the Revelstoke Community Foundation voted to have \$1,000 from the general community fund allocated to the new fund. They will be embarking on a public fundraising initiative so look for future details soon.

In closing I wish to thank my fellow directors and Debra Wozniak -our amazing administrative support person. Special thanks to the Revelstoke Credit Union and Revelstoke Community Futures for their annual contributions to our administration expenses. We are truly grateful to the residents, organizations and businesses who continue to donate.

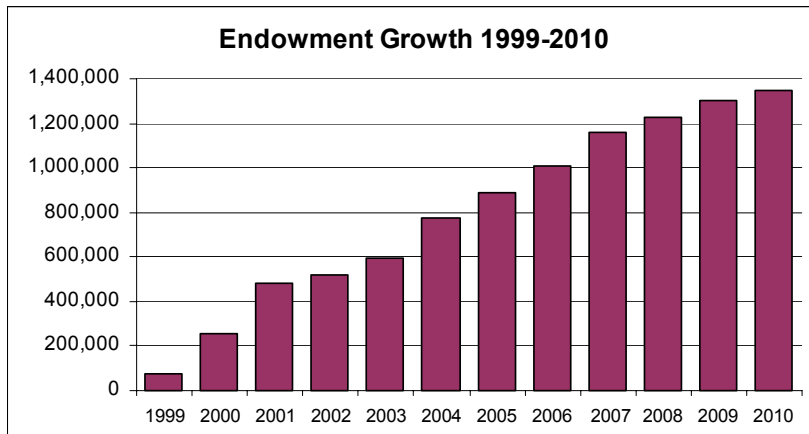
### Representative Organizations

## BUILDING OUR ENDOWMENT

During 2010 contributions to the Foundation were down somewhat – partly due to a delayed effect of poor economic times in recent years and partly due to the Fund Development Committee’s purposely non aggressive approach to seeking donations – so as not to impinge on the efforts of other charitable organizations. Nevertheless, there is a core group of supporters who give regularly and insure steady growth of the endowment.



A major fund established in 2010 was the Jim Holdener Memorial Fund. Additional funds were added to the Railway Museum and Revelstoke Museum’s endowments and also to the General Community Fund and the Hospital Auxiliary Fund. Major donations within the Community Fund were from Southside Food Market and the Revelstoke Golf Club. Our thanks go out to all the donors of 2010. In Memoriam donations are a frequent source of endowment growth and we especially thank families of the deceased who recommend the Foundation as a way to create a permanent memorial to their loved ones.

The Fund Development committee, with Board endorsement, intends to push for the endowment to reach \$1.5M this year. This is an ambitious goal given that the endowment value at December 31, 2010 was just under \$1.35M. We are sure that there are many in Revelstoke who have intentions to give to the Foundation but have never quite gotten around to it. This is a good year to fulfill that intent.

Issues for many who donate to charities are, firstly, “does a particular charity manage its money in a cost effective manner?” and secondly, “how much of one’s donation is used for administrative purposes versus supporting programs?” Your Foundation’s track record on stewardship of the endowment is enviable in that the market value of the endowment is over \$1.4M despite three periods of poor market performance since inception, and the Foundation has virtually no administrative expense thanks to the administrative support supplied by the Revelstoke Credit Union and the Community Futures Development Corporation.

## SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE

The total endowment of scholarships as of December 31, 2010 was \$340,506. In general terms this will produce annual scholarships totalling \$17,000. Not only do we need to see more scholarships established, but many of the existing ones need to be “beefed up” so that they retain their purchasing power in face of inflation.

Additions to scholarships in the past year were made to those in the name of Dennis Lewsey, Ron March, Stella Byman, and Bill Nihilowicz, as well as to the Hillcrest Campbell Award.

We welcome discussions with individuals, businesses, and other organizations interested in establishing new scholarships or adding to existing ones for specific or general purposes. Although Revelstoke has a large number of scholarships currently, the total dollar value of the awards still lags other communities. The cost of post secondary education continues to rise and it behooves us to assist our RSS grads as much as we can in the pursuit of their educational needs for their chosen careers.

The Foundation and the RSS grads who have benefitted from the Foundation’s scholarship initiative, are grateful to the many individuals, businesses, and other organizations who have so strongly responded to the initiative. We are seeking others who will add to the success to date.

## LIVING & GIVING BACK IN REVELSTOKE

Scratch a donor to the Revelstoke Community Foundation and you'll find someone who cares deeply — even passionately — about our community. You'll also discover a person who believes that giving to the Foundation is an effective way to give back to the community.

“It’s a bit of a cliché to say that charity begins at home but that’s what we do,” says Mike Dragani. “I grew up here and this town has been really good to me so I want to give back to it. I think a lot of people are like that.”

Val Berry echoes that sentiment. The former railroader and alderman has been a contributor to the Foundation since its inception more than a decade ago. “Over the years the Foundation has done quite a lot for people in Revelstoke,” he said. “That’s what it’s all about, isn’t it? “Times have changed. Our town has changed — for the better, too.”

Mike Cummings believes in change, too. And why not? As chairman of the Community Futures Development Corporation he helps foment many of the positive changes that have occurred here. CFDC was an early and constant backer of the Foundation and still “kicks in \$3,500 a year to do all the administrative work.” “I think it’s probably a bit of self-interest,” Cummings said. “The returns from the Foundation get ploughed back into the community. And where that money goes is determined by local people — not some bureaucrats in Ottawa or Victoria.”

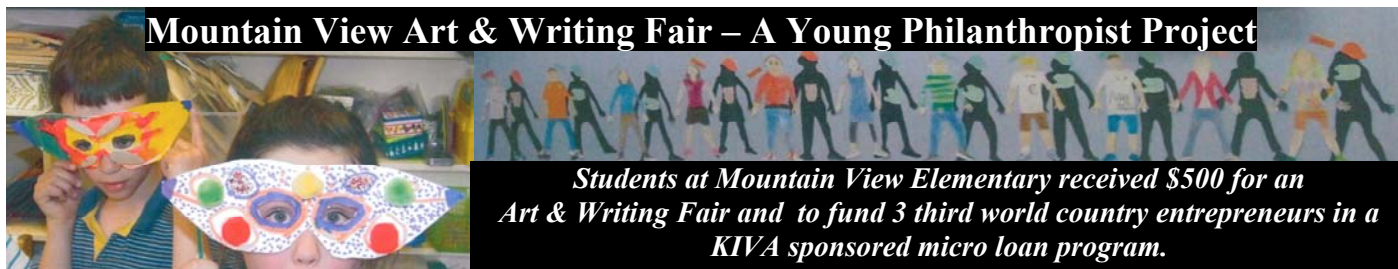
